On July 31, 2025, as required by newly enacted section 120.54(1)(b), Florida Statutes, the Department of Health (Department) published a Notice of Rule Development (NRD) for each of the rules addressed below. Since that time, the Department has remained committed to moving the rules forward, continuing to work on review and finalizing the proposed rule materials. Regrettably, the Department does not believe that it will publish a Notice of Proposed Rule (NPR) by January 27, 2026 for one or more of the following rules.

Therefore, in an abundance of caution and in accordance with section 120.54(2)(a)2., Florida Statutes, the Department provides the following concise statement identifying reasons for delay in rulemaking.

**Rule 64-4.208, MMTC Background Screening:** On September 18, 2025, the Department held a public workshop and received numerous public comments. The Department is finalizing the proposed rule language considering the public comments received at the workshop and in writing.

**Rule 64B21-500.002, Application Form Required for Licensure:** The Department has been working to finalize this rule and is anticipating the publication of the NPR within the next few weeks.

**Rule 64B23-2.001, Documentation for Licensure:** The Department is working with the program to complete the review for this rule and anticipates moving forward as quickly as possible.

**Rule 64B24-2.004, Licensure by Endorsement:** On October 9, 2025, the Department held a rule workshop. Due to technical difficulties during the workshop, the Department scheduled a workshop to be held on November 6, 2025, but had to cancel that meeting. The Department is currently planning to publish a Notice of Workshop in the near future to move forward with the Department's rulemaking.

**Rule 64C-7.002, Collection Procedures for Newborn Screening:** The Department is working on finalizing the NPR documents for this rule. However, the amendment is prospective in nature as section 383.14(2)(a)4., Florida Statutes, provides that the screening for Duchenne muscular dystrophy would begin January 1, 2027, and is subject to legislative appropriation.

**Rule 64V-1.0061, Death and Fetal Death Registration:** The Department has determined that the NRD was too narrow to make the necessary changes to the rule as required. The Department has prepared a Notice of Withdrawal and a new NRD and intends to publish these by January 30, 2026.

**Rule 64W-6.001, Definitions; Rule 64W-6.003, Documentation Requirements:** In addition to these two rules, the Department is making changes to several rules within this chapter as noticed in the NRD published on July 31, 2025. It is important for these rules to move forward as a group to have a functional application cycle in 2026. As a result, this has taken additional time for review and revisions, but the Department is actively working to finalize the materials to move as quickly as possible with publication of the NPR.
