Since that time, the Department has remained committed to moving the rules forward. In accordance with section 120.54 (2)(a)2., Florida Statutes, the Department provides the following quarterly update on pending rulemaking.

64-4.001 Definitions (NRD 08/29/2025): The Department is finalizing the rule text and expects to publish the Notice of Proposed Rule within 30 days.

64-4.208 MMTC Background Screening (NRD 07/31/2025): The Department is finalizing the rule text and expects to publish the Notice of Proposed Rule within 30 days.

64-4.214 Application for MMTC Licensure (NRD 08/29/2025): The Department is awaiting resolution of litigation related to MMTC licensure prior to moving forward with new rule text.

64-4.220 MMTC Website and Website Purchasing (NRD 08/29/2025): Emergency Rule 64ER22-7, Florida Administrative Register, on which this proposed rule is based, was challenged at the Division of Administrative Hearings and is currently on appeal.

Re: Concise Statement on Department of Health Rulemaking

Dear Mr. Plante:

The Department of Health (Department) published a Notice of Rule Development (NRD) for the rules addressed below. The Department remains committed to moving the rules forward. In accordance with section 120.54(2)(a)2., Florida Statutes, the Department provides the following quarterly update on pending rulemaking.

Rule 64B21-500.002, Application Form Required for Licensure (NRD 07/31/2025): The Department has been working to finalize this rule and anticipates publication of the NPR within 30 days.

Rule 64B23-2.001, Documentation for Licensure (NRD 07/31/2025): The Department has been working to finalize this rule and anticipates publication of the NPR within 30 days.

Rule 64B24-2.004, Licensure by Endorsement (NRD 07/31/2025): On February 5, 2026, the Department held a rule workshop on this and several other midwifery rules, with the hearing record closing on February 13, 2026. The Department is finalizing the proposed rule and anticipates moving this and other midwifery rules forward as quickly as possible.

Rule 64B34-1.001, Documentation for Licensure (NRD 08/08/2025): The Department is finalizing the rule text and expects to publish the Notice of Proposed Rule within 30 days.

Rule 64C-7.002, Collection Procedures for Newborn Screening (NRD 07/31/2025): Statutory changes to the requirements for newborn screening were proposed during the 2026 Florida legislative session, including in Special Session 2026E. House Bill 5301E was approved by Governor Ron DeSantis on June 29, 2026; section 2 of the bill further amends section 383.14, Florida Statutes, to require the Department to begin screening for Infantile Krabbe disease and Metachromatic leukodystrophy beginning January 1, 2027. The Department believes that it would be appropriate to add these two conditions as part of the pending rulemaking and anticipates publication of the NPR within 30 days.



Rule 64D-3.046, Immunization Requirements: Public and Nonpublic Schools, Grades Preschool, Kindergarten Through 12, and Adult Education Classes (NRD 09/10/2025): Following the publication of the Notice of Rule Development and a public workshop on December 12, 2025, in Panama City Beach, the Department received over 1,000 public comments. Subsequently, during the 2026 Florida legislative session, bills were filed related to school immunization requirements. Ultimately, those bills were not successful in passing, and the Department is reviewing next steps for this rule.
