Dear Ms. Holladay:

I have had an opportunity to review your December 13, 2022, correspondence on the above referenced rule and respond as follows.

61G4-18.001(2)(g), F.A.C.: The criteria for this subject matter are located in Rule 61G4-12.011, F.A.C., and state “installation, replacement, disconnection or reconnection of power wiring on the load side of the dedicated existing electrical disconnecting means”. However, if requested, I will ask the Board to add a new subparagraph to 61G4-18.001(3), F.A.C. to clarify this definition and intent.

61G4-18.001(3)(g), F.A.C.: At the same meeting where the Board approved this change it also approved a change to Rule 61G4-12.011(16), F.A.C., to define and incorporate the Florida Building Code. This proposed change was noticed on December 22, 2022.
